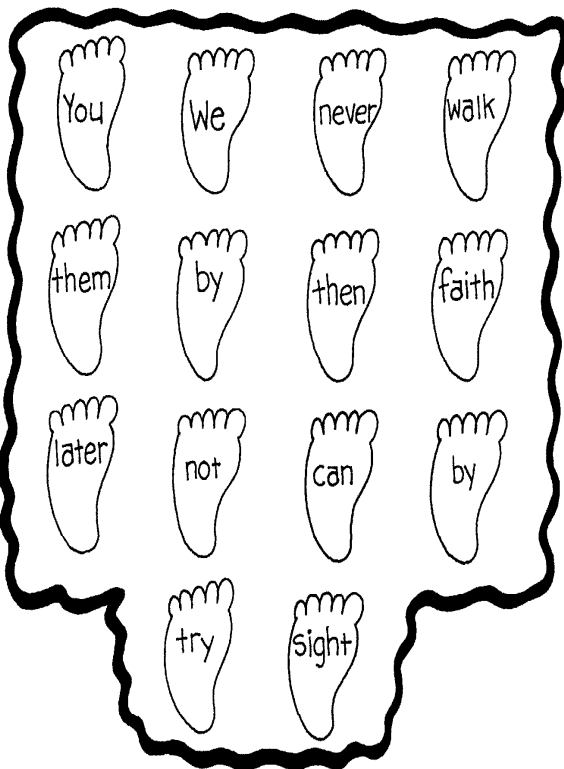

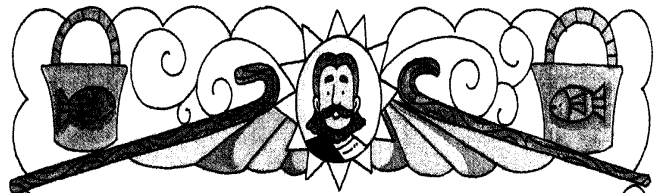
Children's Catholic Corner

Jesus compared the kingdom of God to a mustard seed.

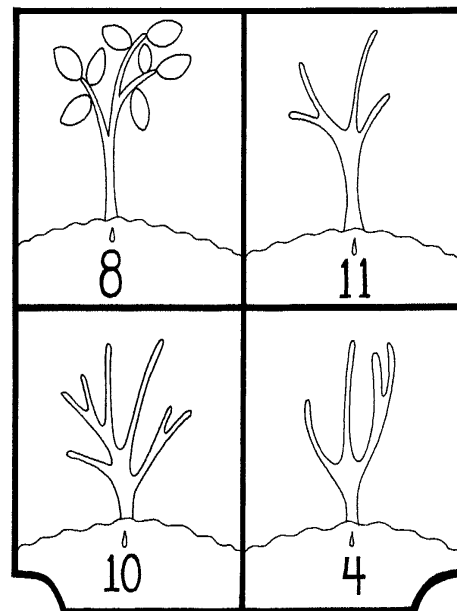
Even though it is the smallest seed, it grows to be the largest plant.
