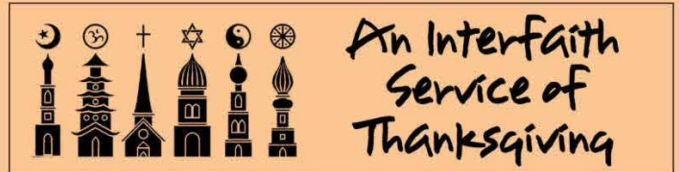
The
