ASH WEDNESDAY – 14 FEBRUARY

Wednesday, 14 February is Ash Wednesday, the first day of the season of Lent. It is a day of universal fast and abstinence in the Church. Ashes will be distributed at the following liturgical celebrations:

Our Saviour

7:45 a.m. Mass

12:05 p.m. Choral Mass (Music of Allegri and Morales)
3:00 p.m. Liturgy of the Word
5:10 p.m. Mass

SACRED HEARTS OF JESUS AND MARY
9:00 a.m. Mass
5:15 p.m. Mass

N.B. Ashes are blessed during the liturgy and imposed after the homily.

LENTEN REGULATIONS

The Lenten regulations include almsgiving and acts of penance. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence.

FASTING obliges all those who have reached the age of 18 and continues to oblige until age 59. Those not specifically obliged to fast are encouraged to join in the discipline of fasting to the extent that they are able. Fasting requires that only one full meal be taken per day. Two other smaller meals may be taken during the day to maintain physical strength, but these two meals together should not equal a full meal in quantity.

ABSTINENCE obliges those who have reached the age of 14 and continues to oblige throughout life. Abstinence prohibits the eating of meat on a particular day.

ASH WEDNESDAY: FAST AND ABSTIENCE

This year, the largely secular celebration of St. Valentine's Day (14 February) coincides with Ash Wednesday and some have inquired if a dispensation from the obligations to fast and abstain from meat will be given.

Catholics throughout the world recognize Ash Wednesday as the solemn beginning of a period of prayerful reflection and penance, which is evident by the large number of church goers on this day.

In view of the significance of Ash Wednesday, the obligation of fast and abstinence must naturally be the priority in the Catholic community. Valentine's Day can appropriately be celebrated the Tuesday before Ash Wednesday, which also happens to be Mardi Gras, a traditionally festive time before beginning our Lenten observance.
