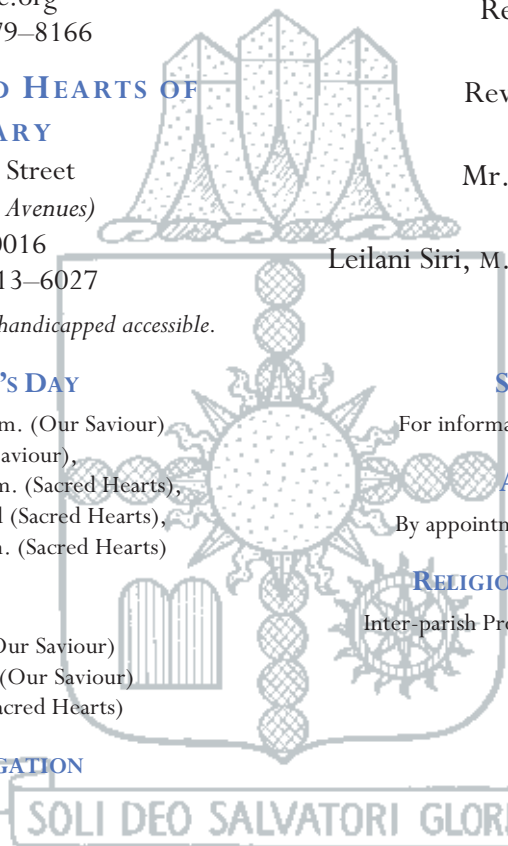

THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

“Go, make disciples of all the nations.” That in some real sense the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Ghost are They whom we are bound to serve and worship, from whom comes the Gospel of grace, and in whom the profession of Christianity centers, surely is shown, most satisfactorily and indisputably, by the words of this text. When Christ was departing, he gave commission to his Apostles, and taught them what to teach and preach; and first of all they were to introduce their converts into his profession, or into his Church, and that by a solemn rite, which, as he had told Nicodemus at an earlier time, was to convey a high spiritual grace. This solemn and supernatural ordinance of discipleship was to be administered in the Name – of whom? – in the Name (can we doubt it?) of him whose disciples the converts forthwith became; of that God whom, from that day forward, they confessed and adored. – *Bl. OF WARDROBES AND RINGS

See the New York premiere of a new play by David Payne. J.R.R. Tolkien and C.S. Lewis were lions of twentieth century British fantasy, giants of a literary genre that reached millions of readers, young and old alike, with mystifying adventures to entertain and deep truths to move people’s hearts. Lewis (*The Chronicles of Narnia*) and Tolkien (*The Lord of the Rings*) were also distinguished faculty members at Oxford University and participants in a literary group known as The Inklings. Their robust philosophical discourse served an uncommon friendship that was not without its differences. Life’s circumstances and sometimes unresolved disagreements forced an uncomfortable season of estrangement. In *Wardrobes and Rings*, we join “Jack” and “Tollers,” as they knew each other, at Oxford’s historic Eagle and Child pub for one last visit, tempered by thawing humor, confession and reconciliation. OF INTEREST

On Saturday, 19 May, Pope Francis announced that the Church would officially recognize the sainthood of Pope Paul VI and Archbishop Oscar Romero. They will be canonized on 14 October 2018. Paul VI (born Giovanni Battista Montini) led the Catholic Church from 1963 until his death in 1978. Oscar Romero, the archbishop of San Salvador, was martyred while celebrating Mass in 1980. He was an outspoken opponent of military oppression during the civil war in El Salvador in the late 1970s and 1980s.

On Sunday, 20 May, Pope Francis announced his intent to create fourteen new cardinals in a consistory that will take place at the Vatican on 29 June, the Solemnity of Sts. Peter & Paul. The new cardinals represent the universality of the Church and include prelates from Iraq, Pakistan, Italy, Poland, Peru, Japan, Madagascar, and several Vatican officials.
