Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Romans 9:1-5

Relative Faith

When someone you love is in trouble, you desire their freedom so strongly that you might say, "I would gladly trade places." For example, parents looking at a sick child in a hospital bed would accept the sickness themselves if they could—if only it would free the child they love. Your love for the afflicted is stronger than the force that renders them helpless.


St. Paul felt this way about those not believing in Christ. He says to the Romans, "I could wish that I myself were accursed and cut off from Christ for the sake of my own people, my kindred according to the flesh."

Paul's own kindred had not all joined him in faith. Ironically, Jesus had the same kindred. To the Israelites belonged the adoption, the glory, the covenants, the law, the worship, and the promises. Christ was theirs, also, according to the flesh. Paul regretted that his relatives did not all embrace Christ according to the Spirit. He loved these people so much that he was willing to trade places. He loved them more strongly than the forces of unbelief.

In our society many people have still not accepted Christ. They do not hear his voice in the Scriptures. They do not experience his love in the community. They do not lift their voices in prayer. They do not join him at table for the Eucharist. The pain we feel renews our conviction to proclaim Christ.

Thanks to your generosity...

We are looking forward to a few improvements that will enhance the comfort and safety of everyone at St. Norbert. Thanks to your generosity in the **For Christ Forever** Diocesan Capital Campaign, we have surpassed our first target amount, and have received rebates totaling \$153,000. These funds, along with a number of directed donations, will enable us to begin a much-needed project.

In a few weeks, our original 47-year-old church pews will be sent back to the manufacturer, Cardinal Company, for refinishing and new kneelers. The pews will be removed on Monday, August 11, and are scheduled to be returned on Friday, August 29. We will have chairs on loan for 2 weekends. For safety reasons, these chairs will not have kneelers. During this time we will stand, rather than kneel during the Eucharistic prayer.

Another project, still in the planning stages, is the repair and resurfacing of our parking lot. We are currently working with the Diocesan Construction Office to define the specifications for the project. When that is finalized the project will be sent out to bid with diocesan-approved contractors.

We realize there will be a bit of inconvenience and disruption to your normal routines during these projects, but we are counting on your patience and understanding while the work is underway. We thank God for your generosity that makes these improvements possible for the good of all in the St. Norbert community.

Wondering Why

In addition to describing an extraordinary event in the life of Jesus and his disciples, today's Gospel is filled with symbolic meaning for all Christians of all times.

The disciples are alone in a boat; Jesus is not with them. The boat, full of disciples, is a symbol of the church. When it is sailing without the presence of Jesus, it encounters tremendous storms. Yet, at the darkest time of the night, the disciples see Jesus in the distance, walking toward them across the turbulent sea.

In scripture, water is a double symbol. First, it symbolizes chaos. This evolves from the first creation story in Genesis, where we are taught that the world was a formless void (chaos), and the *ruah* (spirit or breath of God) blew over the waters. Before God brought order into creation, only chaos, existed.

In this story, the boat (which is the church), is threatened by the storm and the chaos of the sea, which seems out of control. The disciples are terrified when they see someone walking toward them across the waters and at first do not realize that it is Jesus. Jesus says to them, "Take courage, it is I, do not be afraid."

Frequently in the Gospels Jesus instructs the disciples not to be afraid. It is so easy to be discouraged and afraid of the chaos in our lives if we don't recognize that Jesus is right there with us. But, Jesus is not overcome by the stormy chaos, in fact he is walking right over the chaos, toward his disciples, toward his church.

Peter cries out to the Lord to come to him and Jesus calls Peter to himself. When we are caught in chaos and cry out to Jesus in our distress, he answers and beckons us to come to him in our fear. Peter, in faith, jumps out of the boat, and like Jesus he also is able to conquer the chaos and walk across the water, until he begins to rely on his own power instead of that of the Lord. Then, he sinks into the water, into chaos. As long as we depend upon the strength of the Lord, we can walk across the chaos in our lives, and in our church, but as soon as we begin to depend upon our own abilities, we sink into the stormy sea.

But, the story doesn't end with Peter sinking or drowning in the water. The second symbolic meaning of water is rebirth. As Peter sinks into the waves, Jesus reaches out his hand and pulls him to safety and back into the boat with the other disciples. Even when we have allowed ourselves to be swallowed up in chaos, even when we have separated ourselves from the church (the boat), even then, Jesus reaches out his hand to us, and if we will take it, he will bring us to new life, restore us to our community, and tell us to have faith in him. There is no chaos in life, in the church, in the world, that Jesus cannot overcome.

And, the disciples understood the importance of this event. They understood the power of the one who could calm the storm, save the lives of those in peril, and restore peace. They knew that it could only be the Son of God.

Reflexionemos sobre la Palabra de Dios

El Evangelio de este domingo presenta a Jesús abriéndose camino para llegar a una barca de discípulos en medio de una tempestuosa oscuridad con mucho oleaje y grandes vientos. A las tres de la mañana se encuentra a los discípulos siendo sacudidos por los vientos de sus propios miedos. Entonces Pedro, que siempre parece decir lo correcto por decir lo inoportuno en el tiempo oportuno, grita por encima del tumulto: “Señor, si eres tú, mándame ir hacia ti sobre las aguas”. A lo que Jesús le responde: “Ven”.

Ahí es cuando Pedro debe decidir si se queda seguro en la plataforma o se baja de la misma para entrar en la montaña rusa. Asombrosamente Pedro decide arriesgarse y tirarse al tempestuoso torbellino de la vida. Allí comienza a hundirse y ahogarse, pero es también allí donde descubre a Dios, que le tiende la mano y lo levanta. Si no se hubiese arriesgado y se hubiera quedado en la barca, tal vez no hubiera llegado a conocer la mano salvadora de Dios. También se dio cuenta que lo que Jesús vino a predicar no era cosa de parque de diversiones y juegos, sino un reino donde la vida se experimenta sólo a través de grandes riesgos.

Así es la historia de todos nosotros cuando tenemos que escoger entre una vida de aparente seguridad y la vida verdadera, que siempre se revela por medio del riesgo y la confianza. Tales oportunidades de opciones se dan cuando enfrentamos la posibilidad de necesitar consejería matrimonial o de ser padres por primera vez, o de ser padres un poco tarde, perder el empleo, el cónyuge, la salud, o aun lo que pudiera parecer la pérdida de la fe. En esos momentos no salirse de la barca y tirarse en la turbulenta tempestad, no arriesgarlo todo en aras de todo, sería perderlo todo. Por otro lado, salir aunque fuese con miedo sería encontrarnos con nuestro Dios Salvador.

Gracias a su generosidad...

Estamos por hacer algunas reparaciones que mejorarán la comodidad y seguridad de todos en San Norberto. Gracias a su generosidad durante la campaña diocesana **Para Cristo Siempre**, ya superamos nuestra primera meta y hemos recibido reembolsos por un total de \$153.000. Estos fondos, junto con una serie de donaciones, nos permitirán comenzar un proyecto muy necesario.

En pocas semanas, las bancas originales de la iglesia, que ya tienen 47 años, se enviarán al fabricante, la Compañía Cardinal, para que les instalen nuevos reclinatorios y les den un nuevo acabado. Las bancas se retirarán el lunes 11 de agosto y se ha programado que serán devueltas el viernes 29 de agosto. Tendremos sillas prestadas durante dos fines de semana. Por razones de seguridad, estas sillas no tendrán reclinatorios. Durante el tiempo de la plegaria eucarística nos pondremos de pie, en lugar de arrodillarnos

Otro proyecto aún en etapa de planificación es la reparación y repavimentación de nuestro lote de estacionamiento. Actualmente estamos trabajando con la oficina diocesana de construcción para definir las especificaciones del proyecto. Cuando el proyecto esté finalizado se enviará a contratistas aprobados por la Diócesis para el proceso de licitación.

Entendemos que durante estos proyectos habrá un poco de molestias y perturbación en su rutina normal, por lo que estamos contando con su paciencia y comprensión mientras que las obras están en marcha. Damos gracias a Dios por su generosidad, la cual hace posible estas mejoras para el bien de todos en la comunidad de San Norberto.


