



Prayer Blanket Ministry Mrs. Ruby Duhon

The prayer blanket is a crocheted lap-ghan. Prayers are said with every stitch. The colors usually represent the illness. It measures 40' x 52" with an insert of a cross. Example: For bone cancer—the cross would be yellow with a purple background. After the blanket is completed is it folded, wrapped with a ribbon and accompanied by a prayer card. Then brought to be blessed by Fr. Mark. The blanket is usually requested by a friend or family member. It is not sold but a donation to help pay for supplies is appreciated. Once the recipient receives the blanket "PLEASE" unwrap it and use it.
