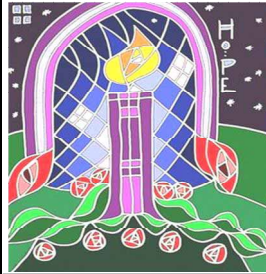

# FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT

## Pastor's Letter

Dear Parish Family,

Today, we celebrate the First Sunday of Advent, the first of the four Sundays leading up to Christmas. During this Advent Season, the church looks back on Christ's coming in celebration while at the same time looking forward in eager anticipation to the coming of Christ's kingdom when he returns for His people. Advent is intended to be a season of fasting, much like Lent. It is also a time for reflection on the violence and evil in the world which causes us to cry out to God to make things right. It is a time for self-examination of our sinfulness and asking for His grace to renew and conform us into His image. May we celebrate this Advent Season in this spirit.

Across the United States, hundreds of religious communities lack financial resources sufficient to meet the retirement and health-care needs of their aging members. These religious men and women devoted their lives working in the service of God to help others for small stipends, with little, if any, retirement savings. For this urgent need, I ask you to support and give generously for the "retirement collection" this weekend.

We will celebrate a "Healing Mass" here on Monday, December 4 at 7:30 PM in the Church. We have invited a guest speaker, Mary Ann Collett, an inspiring and dynamic Catholic Charismatic Evangelist. She has shared with me about her healing ministry, especially here in the United States. I invite all of you, especially those who are suffering from some form of illness, physical or spiritual, to come and join us at this Mass.

This week, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. Mass will be celebrated on the Thursday evening vigil at 7:30 PM and on Friday at 9:00 AM in the Church. The Immaculate Conception is the patroness of the United States. The feast day is also important in Argentina, Brazil, Korea, Nicaragua, Paraguay, the Philippines, Spain, and Uruguay. It is an important date in salvation history and a Holy Day of Obligation. Come join us in our celebration as we honor Mary, the Mother of God, and celebrate her Immaculate Conception.

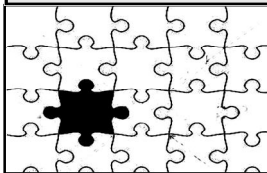

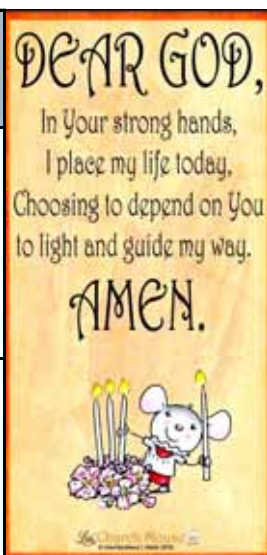

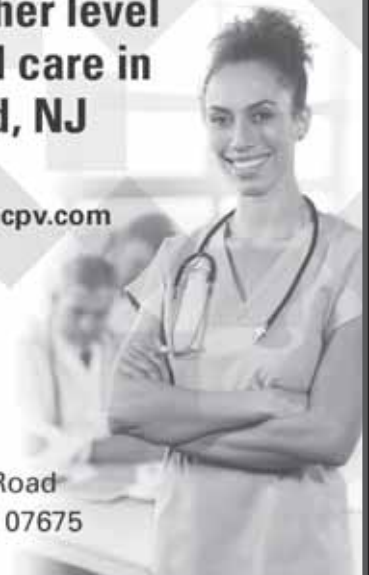
