I'm running a bit behind: on Saturday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>, at the 5:00 PM Pentecost Sunday Eucharist, **Elzah Herrera** shared in communion for the first time. Sorry Elzah for being so late in acknowledging your first communion.

I will be attending the local priest gathering for the World Day for the Sanctification of Priests (every year on the day before the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus) Thursday afternoon, June 22<sup>nd</sup>. We will have prayer from 3:00 – 5:00 PM and end with a meal prepared for us by the **Serra Club**. Therefore Mass will not be celebrated in Cistern on Thursday. Please keep us priests in your prayers.

Preparations have been made for the Sacred Heart Parish celebration of the parish feast day, the **Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus**, Friday, June 23<sup>rd</sup>.
