## Sharing God's Mercy: 2016 BISHOP'S APPEAL

Dear Parishioners of St. Agnes,

### Summary-

Total revenues in 2015 were \$762K against total expenses of \$717K, which yielded net income of \$44,864. The net income of \$44,864 has been added to our much needed general account. The ideal amount for the general account is between \$175K – 200K. *The above financial activity does not include monies received for Building Improvements and the Parish Share of the Diocesan Campaign.*

**Building Improvement Reserve:** The opening balance in the Building Improvement account was \$18,059. During the year, donations received totaled \$48,362 which leaves us a balance, at the end of the year, of \$66,421.

**Parish Share of Diocesan Campaign:** In 2015, we received \$23K for the Parish Share of the Diocesan Campaign. These monies have been deposited in a separate bank account.

### **Revenue:**

Plate collections were more than the budget and \$65K more than what was received in 2014.

Fund raisers were less than the budget and less than 2014 totals.

EFT Giving increased by 25% in 2015.

### **Expenses:**

Expenses were effectively managed in 2015.

Some budgeted \$'s were not used, rates and contracts were renegotiated, and a staff position was eliminated.

**Donations:** In 2015 the Parish generously gave \$42K in donations to various organizations. Additionally, Parishioners gave more than \$93K to the Diocesan Capital Campaign in 2015.

**Is the Bishop's Appeal different than the "Reclaiming Christ's Mission Together Capital Campaign?"** Yes. The Bishop's Appeal funds are completely different components than the capital campaign, with the exception of priests' retirement. The money received from the Appeal will be applied to the components listed above and is completely separate from the capital campaign account.
