Verse before the gospel: *"One does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes forth from the mouth of God."*

Responsorial Psalm Meditation

Ps 91:1-2, 10-15

The Responsorial Psalm contains the saying that Satan would quote when he was tempting Jesus in the desert: "For to his angels he has given command about you, that they guard you in all your ways. Upon their hands they shall bear you up, lest you dash your foot against a stone."

The irony of Satan quoting this saying is that it is contained in a psalm that professes a radical trust in God. The psalmist speaks of God being his refuge and his fortress.

Satan, on the other hand, uses the saying to try to tempt Jesus away from trusting the providence of God. He wants Jesus to orchestrate a situation in which he would force the Father to rescue him.

This would not be an act of trust, but a form of manipulation. When one truly trusts and loves another, one does not play games with that person's love.
