- **LENTEN REGULATIONS:** Prayer, Fasting & Almsgiving: All Catholics between ages 14 and older must fast and abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays during the season of Lent. To fast means to eat one full meal and the other two should be less than the normal amount, with no snacks between meals. The faithful should receive the sacrament of Penance during Lent and prior to Thriduum. This is a time we must attend daily Holy Mass and to live a holy life.
