I tinerary

October 20, 2019 • Depart for Mexico City

Upon arrival, you will be greeted by your tour guide and driven to your hotel in Mexico City. Enjoy free time before dinner, which will be held at a local restaurant.

Meals: Dinner

October 21, 2019 • Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe and San Juan Teotihuacan

After breakfast, you will walk through the Plaza of the Three Cultures, which symbolizes the unique blend of pre-Hispanic and Hispanic cultures that make up Mexico. You will visit the Church of Santiago Tlatelolco, where St. Juan Diego was baptized, and continue to the Shrine of Guadalupe which was built in response to our Lady's request, where Mass will be celebrated. Following Mass, you will have the opportunity to kneel in front of the "tilma," where our Lady's image was miraculously imprinted. Following the tour of the Shrine, you will visit San Juan Teotihuacan, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. While there, you will enjoy lunch at a nearby restaurant, followed by a guided tour of the archaeological zone. Your day will conclude with dinner at the hotel.

October 22, 2019 • Mexico City

Your day will begin with breakfast, followed by Mass at the National Cathedral. You will then visit the Holy Family Church, where you will view the tomb of Fr. Miguel Agustin Pro, the Jesuit martyr, and visit his dedicated Museum. After the visit, you will tour the oldest and



largest cathedral in all of Latin America, the Metropolitan Cathedral. Your tour will continue at the National Palace, where you will view some amazing murals painted by Diego Rivera. You will visit the Plaza of Santo Domingo, which is home to the Church of Santo Domingo, the first church built by the Dominicans in 1576; and the Shrine of Our Lady of the Rosary, the first Rosary Shrine in Mexico. Additionally, you will visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Covadonga, the headquarters of the Confraternity of the Most Holy Rosary, which is dedicated to the Patron Saint of Asturias, Spain. There, you will see both the old and new Basilica and have an opportunity to climb the hill to visit the little chapel. After your tour, you will return to the hotel and enjoy dinner at a local restaurant Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

October 23, 2019 • Excursion to Puebla

You will enjoy a spectacular drive to what is known as Mexico's most beautiful

city, Puebla. On your drive, you will climb to over 10,000 ft. above sea level and view two magnificent peaks, one covered with snow and the other an active volcano. Following lunch, you will visit Puebla's Cathedral, St. Dominic's Church, and its Chapel of Our Lady of

the Rosary. Mass will be celebrated at the Church of St. Francis of Assisi and after, you will view the incorrupt body of St. Sebastian of Aparicido and the Chapel of St. Michel and Chapel of el Rosario. You will return to Mexico City for dinner at a local restaurant. **Meals: Breakfast, Dinner**
