Sick Calls – Please call the rectory to arrange for Father Jasany to bring the Sacraments when a member of your family is hospitalized.

Weddings – Parishioners are asked to call the rectory office at least 6 months in advance of the wedding to schedule an appointment with Father Jasany.

Baptisms – The 1st & 3rd Sunday of the month at 12:00 pm. Parents are required to attend Pre-Baptism Class.

Arrangements must be made a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the date of baptism. Before parents baptize their child, Diocesan and parish policy requires you to complete a Baptism Preparation Class.

The next class will be on Sunday, March 6th at Our Lady of Lourdes Parish at 11:45 am. Reservations needed; please call 216-2641-2829 to make your reservation.

Godparent and Sponsor Certificate – Sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation must be registered and practicing members of the Church, attending weekly and Holy Day Masses for a minimum of 3 months prior to the celebration of the Sacraments for which they have requested the certificate. Please note individuals 18 years of age and older, no longer in school, need to register.

Pastor's Paragraphs

Dear Parishioners,

We warmly welcome Father Matthew Glaros, who will be living at St. John Nepomucene rectory. He will be serving in the field of hospital ministry as hospital chaplain at University Hospital's Case Medical Center of Cleveland. Father Glaros has been ordained sixteen years; he served eleven years as an Air Force chaplain in a variety of assignments. Father Glaros' biography is in this weekend's parish bulletin.

Lent is upon us. We undertake this journey together of prayer, fasting and almsgiving so that we can become "new creations" in Christ this Easter. At the entrance doors of our church, we have the Lenten black meditation books, the packets for Operation Rice Bowl and refrigerator magnets which list the corporal and spiritual works of mercy. Also on the radiators by the entrance doors, we have invitation cards inviting you, your family and friends to come to confession on Wednesday, February 24th from 5 to 8 pm, as well as confession guides. I invite you to take invitation cards and extend this invitation to others to come to confession on February 24th.

Possibly, we can summarize this Lent as a time to receive mercy and as a time to extend mercy. Priests at every Catholic Church in the Cleveland Diocese will be hearing confessions from 5 to 8 pm on Wednesday, February 24th. You are asked to invite people who may have fallen away from the regular practice of the Catholic Faith to come to confession. You can come to confession with them.

Everyone is welcome to come to confession on this evening. We will also host a Communal Penance Service with confessions on Monday, March 7th at 7 pm.

In the Sacrament of Penance, we meet the Merciful Face of God. We are familiar with the parable of the Prodigal Son who returns to his father after squandering his inheritance on foolish pursuits. His father welcomes the prodigal son with open arms and throws him a celebration. Similarly, Our Heavenly Father wishes to extend His Merciful Love to all of us. This happens in the Sacrament of Penance.

In addition to going to confession yourself, please consider extending this special invitation to others.

May we receive mercy and extend mercy to others.

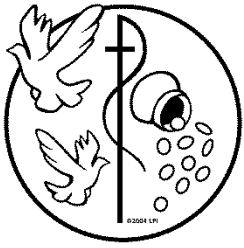
