HOLDEN'S HOPE FOREVER

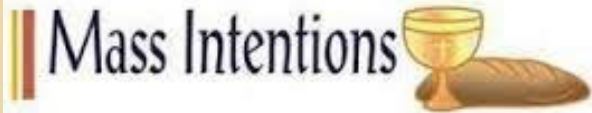

April 27 - 29, 2018

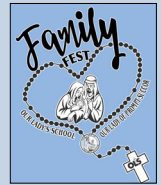
Adult volunteers are needed to work two-hour sessions at our annual Family Fest.

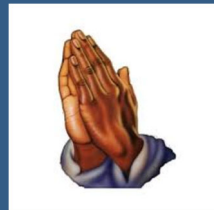
