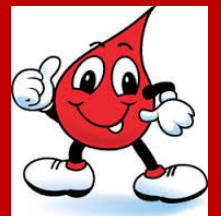
With the Easter Lilies removed, the altar is bare and there are many weekends available for beautiful flowers on the altar.

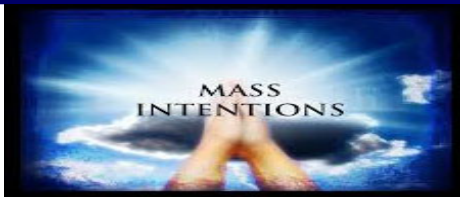
The cost is \$125 for both arrangements.

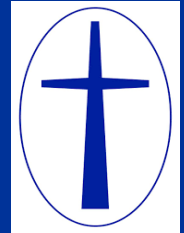

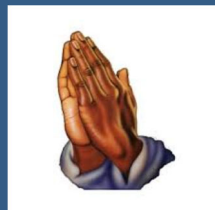
