We currently have a balance of \$5,365.00 in the AC Fund.

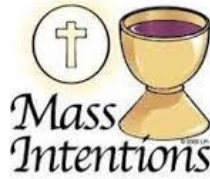

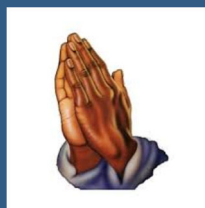
