PRAYER PARTNERS - It has been shown that young people who feel "connected" to their parish family are more likely to continue on in their faith life in the Catholic church. Because of this, the Religious Ed teachers and I have decided to try a new program, called Prayer Partners. We will partner an adult volunteer with a child, and they will pray for each other, and spend time together on the first Wednesday of the month during CCD time (7 - 8 PM). We will meet at St. Boniface Hall at 7 PM, and the first 15 minutes will be time to spend with your partner, to learn about each other, teach prayers, find out what is going on in their lives, etc. That will be followed by 30 minutes of fun time - board games, puzzles, cards, etc., and the evening will end after a 10 minute refreshment time.
