ARCHBISHOP'S CALL TO SHARE



Please prayerfully consider how to best make your sacrificial offering this year. Our established target goals are **\$6,863.00 for St. Boniface**; and **\$3,269.00 for St. Therese**. As of last Wednesday, there were responses from 39% of the St. Boniface parishioners (42 families), who have pledged \$5,279.00, or 77% of the target, with an average gift of \$126.00. There were responses from 59% of the St. Therese parishioners (27 families), who have pledged \$4,930.00, or 151% of the target, with an average gift of \$183.00. **Thank you!**

Stations of the Cross will begin at 7:00 PM on Fridays at St. Therese on February 20th, March 6th, and March 20th and at St. Boniface on February 27th, March 13th, and March 27th.

Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available on all Wednesdays of Lent (except Ash Wednesday) in the Cry Room at St. Boniface from 6 - 7 PM; every Saturday afternoon from 3 - 3:45 PM in the Sacristy at St. Boniface; any time by appointment, and we will have a Communal Reconciliation Service at St. Boniface on Palm Sunday, March 29th, at 5:00 PM.

Ash Wednesday (02/18) and Good Friday (04/03) are Days of Fast and Abstinence (no meat and only one full meal, with no eating between meals)- for Catholics who are 18 years of age and not yet 60 years old. All other Fridays of Lent are Days of Abstinence (no meat, and practice of some sort of sacrificial offering or service) for all Catholics who are over the age of 14. Lenten "Rice Bowls" available at each church, are ways of highlighting sacrificial giving, and offer suggestions for how to do this. Please take a "Rice Bowl" home and use it as a family. Collection bins for the Rice Bowls will be in place as of Palm Sunday - March 29th and throughout Holy Week.

Not by Bread Alone, a Daily Reflection Book for Lent, is available on the tables in back of each church. There are enough for one book per family - please take one and use it individually or as a family throughout the season.

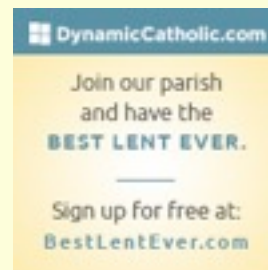
