FEASTDAY OF ST. BONIFACE - is this Tuesday, June 5th. In honor of the Parishes patron saint, the relic of St. Boniface that was brought over by the Carmelites from Straubing, Bavaria in the 1850s, will be brought from its place of honor above the Tabernacle and placed on the Altar of Sacrifice for our veneration this weekend. OBERAMMERGAU 2020 - The world-famous Passion Play of Oberammergau, Germany, will be performed again in 2020. It has been performed every ten years, consistently, since 1634. There are several pilgrimage packages offered, between mid-May through the end of September, 2020, that include airfare from New York, accommodations, Play Tickets, most meals, Professional Escorted Sightseeing, and all service charges - and the prices run from \$3,369.00 - \$4,699.00, and the length of the trips are from 9 days through 12 days, depending on the pilgrimage chosen (all of them include Oberammergau combined with other locations, such as Austria, Switzerland, Italy, Poland, Hungary, Czech Republic, France, Greece and the Holy Land). If you might be interested in going and planning for such a pilgrimage, please call me or drop me an e-mail. We will then have a planning meeting on Monday evening, June 11th, at St. Boniface Parish Hall, at 7:00 PM to choose a package.
