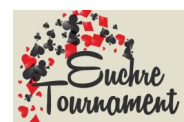

The main dishes, sides, desserts & drinks will be provided. Each family is asked to bring a dessert to share.



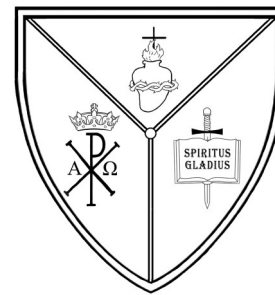
Donors are needed to provide mashed potatoes, stuffing, & green beans. Please use the slips in the pews to indicate your preferences.

As we continue to deal with the sexual abuse crisis in the Church, we will have some listening and discussion times for our parishioners. This Open Forum Discussion will be led by Liesl Gyurko-Crites and Fr. Mark. Liesl is a public children services professional and a parent/parishioner. The idea is to answer questions parents may have about talking with their children regarding multiple topics that have been in the news lately. This is not a discussion to answer specific questions about current criminal cases, but an opportunity to ask questions and get information. We are open to discussing topics you may have, such as; learning the judicial and Church processes, how we work to keep our children safe and steps our own parishes have already taken to ensure safety. Your own concerns and questions will also be heard and addressed.

The first session will be on Sunday, November 18, in Christ the King Church during Religious Education time (11:15 A.M. - 12:00 P.M.). The second time will be on Tuesday, November 20, at 7:00 P.M. in the Holy Family Center. Hopefully all those concerned can find the time to attend one of these sessions.

A parishioner sent an email and suggested that parishioners may want to make a pilgrimage to the parishes in Glouster and Buchtel to pray with the folks at Mass and let them know of our parishes' support and concern. Perhaps some of you may consider going to the weekend Mass on Saturday, November 17, at 5:30 P.M. at St. Mary of the Hills or Sunday, November 18, at 9:00 A.M. at Holy Cross to show your support and be a healing presence for the parishioners there.

Directions to Holy Cross, Glouster: Take US-33 W to 682 The Plains / Chauncey. Turn right onto 682 and follow that into Chauncey. Turn left onto OH-13 N. Follow OH-13N into Glouster (16.8 mi). Turn right onto Republic Ave. The church will be on the left.

Directions to St. Mary of the Hills, Buchtel: Take US-33 W to Exit 185 (Nelsonville/Buchtel). Turn left onto OH-78 and follow it into Buchtel. The church sits on the right.
