FORTY DAYS FOR LIFE

Beginning February 14, (Ash Wednesday), through March 25, (Palm Sunday), there will be a coordinated international mobilization of prayer and/or fasting for an end to abortion in this country and beyond. We pray that, with God's help, this will begin to happen. **Take a stand for life.**

On Ash Wednesday, English Masses will be celebrated at **10:30 a.m.** (All School Mass) and **6:00 p.m.** A Spanish Mass will be celebrated at **7:30 p.m. in the Chapel.**

LENTEN RULES require Catholics between the ages of 18 and 60 to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. In addition all Catholics 14 years of age and older must abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent.

FASTING as explained by the U.S. Conference of Bishops means partaking of only one full meal during the day. Some food (not equaling another full meal) is permitted at breakfast and around midday or in the evening, depending on when a person chooses to eat the main or full meal.

ABSTINENCE forbids the use of meat, but not of eggs, milk products, or condiments made of animal fat.
