St. Vincent de Paul has a confidential voice mail box. To access the voicemail system, call **452-2977, extension 11**. Messages are retrieved each morning.

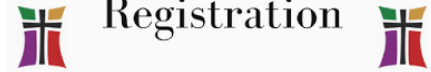
