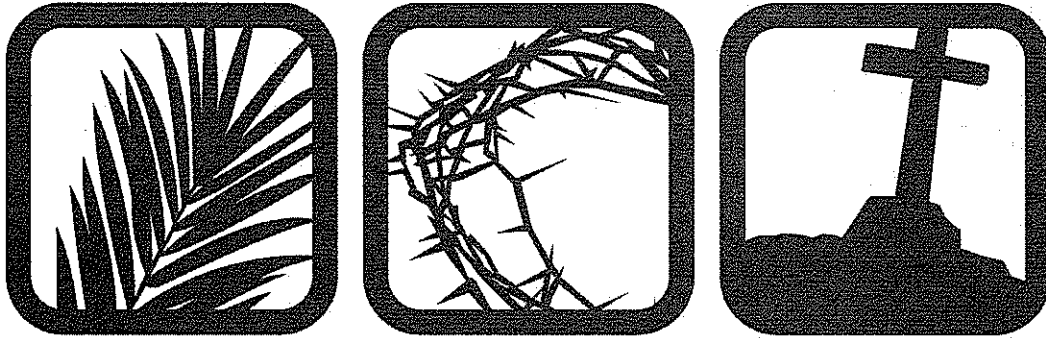

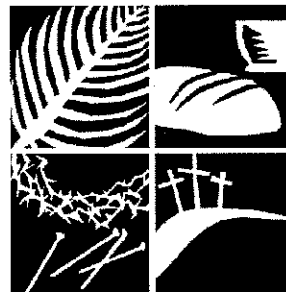

From the Desk of Father Dave

The Great Adventure

I love to travel. It is fun just to plan an adventure and carry it out. Where will I go? What will I do? What will I eat? How will the experience change me? These are all questions I will learn the answer to once I experience where I am going. Holy Week is a new destination we have the chance to encounter each year.

Holy Thursday is a critical day when we encounter the Last Supper. We hear St. Paul tell us about the Paschal meal of bread and wine that become the food for salvation. St. John recalls the Lord washing the feet of his disciples. Jesus showed service to be a Eucharistic action. The institution of the Eucharist and of Priesthood makes this a day worth celebrating.

Good Friday commemorates the death of Jesus. We remember his terrible death and we venerate the wood of the cross. This is the only day of the year that Holy Mass is not said in honor of the death of Jesus. We also remember many different people in our world with special intercessions we pray this day.

On Saturday, we celebrate the Super bowl of all liturgies, the Easter Vigil. We begin in darkness with a small fire that lights a single candle. The flame of the Easter candle spreads to the other candles in the church. We read many readings that outline salvation history. Then Holy Water will be blessed and sprinkled on the people. The sacraments of Initiation including Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist will be celebrated by some for the first time. These adults will become fully initiated into the Catholic Church. Indeed, this is a time of rejoicing not only for these individuals but for the Church as a whole. The resurrection is remembered on this night giving salvation to the world.

On Holy Thursday, you can celebrate either at St. Wenceslaus or St. Scholastica at 7 pm. On Good Friday, St. Wenceslaus there is a Good Friday Ecumenical Service at 3 and 7 pm. There are 3 pm Stations of the Cross at St. Scholastica and 7 pm Good Friday Service at St. John. Something new this year is one Easter Vigil celebrated only at St. Wenceslaus at 7 pm. We hope you can join us for the adventure.

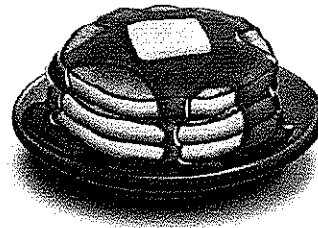

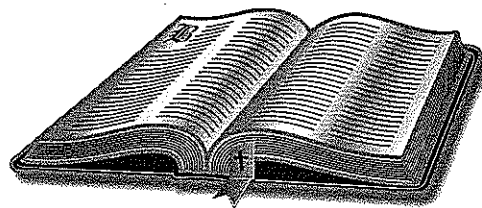

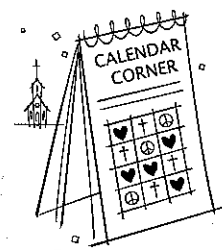
