

It's the Greatest Gift!

We all want to give children the tools they will need to make them happy, loving, contributing members of our society. As parents/grandparents/parishioners, we try to provide them with many opportunities to grow, learn, and develop.

One of the most important gifts we can give them is one that we may easily set aside for when we are less busy, tired, stressed, or anxious. Yet it is the most import gift for our children, and us, to rely on through those stressful times. It is our gift of Jesus. Everything else will come and go, fade away, become obsolete. But not Jesus; He will endure, be our strength, our guide, our hope...

The unwrapping of this gift never stops... we begin when we are baptized into a community of believers. We learn by seeing our parents/grandparents/parishioners live out their relationship with Jesus. We grow as we participate in the liturgy of the Mass... maybe by looking not at what we get from the liturgy – but by what we bring to this liturgy.

There are opportunities all around us to grow in that relationship with Jesus... For our 1st through 8th grade children, we offer St. Wenceslaus School and Faith Formation Sessions. We are here to accompany you in raising children who know and love Jesus. We are all called to discipleship.

LOWC (Liturgy of the Word for Children) is offered during 8:30 and 10:30 Masses most Sundays during the school year for children ages 6-12. Sunday School for our 3-4-5 year olds is being considered. (SW)

For our 9th and 10th grade teens, we have Faith Formation/Confirmation. The NPACC is using the program Chosen. The goal is for our teens to have a personal encounter with Jesus Christ, and if they choose, they will be Confirmed to complete the grace they received at Baptism.

Our Juniors and Seniors have the option of joining a Youth Alive group. Why? Because our learning/growing/need for relationship NEVER ends. This is a critical time in their lives. Is there anyone we would rather have them lean on more than Jesus? Encourage them to join a group.

And for you... there are many opportunities available for you to grow in your personal relationship with Jesus. The more you learn about WHO he is, the more you will understand all the goodness He wants for you. There are all the groups/studies/sessions mentioned in the bulletin last week, but there are also other ways to encounter Christ through service and prayer. From the Desk of Father Dave

Tragedy and Gratitude

Today we remember September 11, 2001. This was a true tragedy and probably anyone over the age of 25 knows right where they were when they heard the news. I was watching television, trying to catch a little news after mass. We were glued to the set for hours. Finally, I just couldn't watch it anymore. We held a big prayer service and mourned the losses our country had on that infamous day. I was so proud of how the NYFD and the NYPD responded. These were brave men and women who rushed in and many lost their lives. This was true with the first victim of 9/11, NYFD Chaplain, Fr. Mychal Judge.

Fr. Judge, who many think should be a saint, always desired to be in the thick of tragedy. He was the protector of the unprotected, suffering a fatal injury that horrible morning right on the scene. More than bravery, Fr. Judge, a Franciscan friar, was also a man of gratitude. Fr. Michael Duffy, the funeral homilist, recalled what Mychal Judge said he needed: "Absolutely nothing. I don't need a thing in the world. I am the happiest man on the face of the earth. And then he would go on for ten minutes, telling me how blessed he felt. 'I have beautiful sisters. I have nieces and nephews. I have my health. I'm a Franciscan priest. I love my work. I love my ministry.'"

Isn't it fantastic that a man who will be forever linked to one of the most horrible events in the history of our nation was a person of gratitude? Many tragic things happen in our world. As people of faith, we need to grieve loss but cling to hope. In times of pain, we are called to unite our cross to the cross of Jesus. In this we can peel back the layers of despair and know true gratitude. The gratitude of knowing we are true children of God. Make this a reflective day.
