**From the Desk of Deacon Bob Wagner****THE CCW: FEMALE CATHOLIC DISCIPLESHIP IN ACTION**

The greatest advantage I have as an ordained Deacon is that I have the great grace to be married. As a married man, I have nothing but the highest admiration for my wife Ruth, who remains to this very day, the best of all educators who have taught me. Unlike many educators, she lives and teaches by example and rarely by word. As an apt student, I have learned much by observing and trying to emulate the way she lives. I remember telling Archbishop Roach that it is she who should have been ordained a Deacon, not I, for she fully lives the ministry of the ordained Catholic Deacon.

We have, within our parish, two very wonderful examples of Christian discipleship: the Council of Catholic Women at the St. Wenceslaus site and Our Lady of Good Help Council of Catholic Women at the WCC sites. Our two CCWs are more than a quiet cloister of contemplative women who pray. While it is true that their faith and prayer are central to both CCWs, they can be best described as "prayer in action." They are living examples of the attributes of both Martha and Mary, as portrayed in the Gospel of John.

This Sunday morning the St. Wenceslaus CCW is hosting the Belgian Waffle Breakfast, the proceeds to benefit the many ministries of the parish and the greater work of the Church. This evening they are vital to our Prayer of Remembrance for the deceased of our parish community, taking part in our prayer and later in the hospitality following the prayer. Our Lady of Good Help CCW is as involved in the ministries of the WCC. They will also be hosting a breakfast later in the year, the proceeds from which will support the many ministries of the WCC and the greater Church.

With the majority of their membership 65 years of age and older, both of our CCWs are in need of younger women to continue their great ministry of prayer and action within our greater parish community. Our greater parish community will grieve and suffer should these two dynamic CCWs end from lack of members. ### Small Still Voice

Life gets so busy it is easy to get consumed with doing many activities. I'm finally starting to feel back to normal and I am trying to get back into the swing of things. However, one reminder I am given through this illness and my other illnesses is that I must listen to the small still voice inside of me. For me this is Jesus inviting me to slow down and spend time with him. We often feel the need to be entertained and to escape. Jesus invites us to rest with him. Each of us needs to take alone time to listen to the voice, which is the prompting of the Holy Spirit, reminding us to be in union with Jesus.

The small still voice does not want us to be in isolation. No, we are to be intimately connected with those around us. We need to act as the Body of Christ. As Catholics, we find strength in gathering weekly for Mass. We join together, despite age, sex, economic or political background, and for the hour at Mass we put Jesus in the center of our lives. We do this together through Word and Sacrament. When liturgy is done right, we should not feel alone any more. Liturgy should energize us and send us out on a mission to love and serve the Lord. Some of us will do this with words, but most of all we need to do this with our actions. We need to live our lives connected to the universal church.

Elijah found God by listening to the small still voice. The voice isn't in the noisiness of the wind, the fire, or the earthquake, just like it's not in all the bustle of today. Let the small still voice be an anchor in a volatile world. May we trust God and others to be the source of love we need. The small still voice needs to motivate us to be vocal with word and action to help spread the Kingdom of Heaven right here on earth.

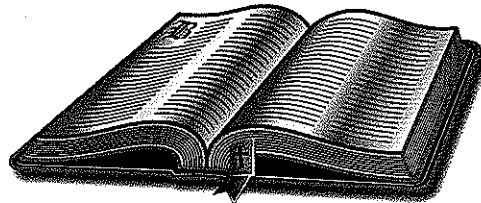

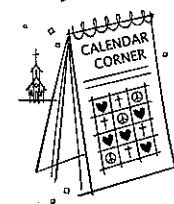
