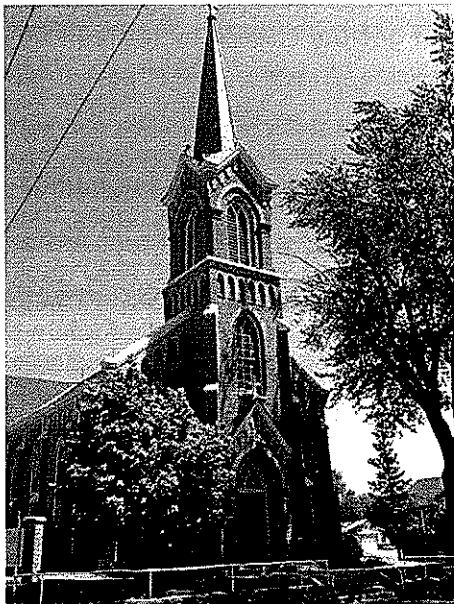

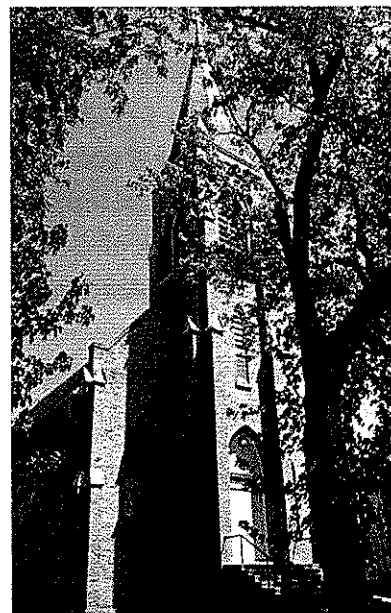

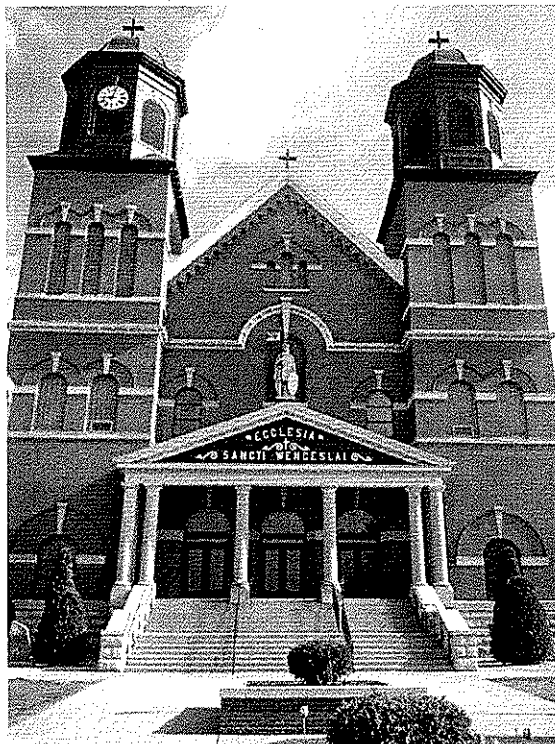

Guatemala Mission Trip News

Our journey to Guatemala began early Sunday morning. After two flights, we had a three-hour drive to San Lucas Toliman. Not long into our ride, we drove into pouring rain with increasing amounts of lightning. At one point, lightning struck right above us. Thankfully, there was no damage to the abundant power lines around us. This was our first eye-opening experience. We safely pulled into our hotel and got the chance to settle in before dinner.

The next morning, some of us woke up early to watch the sun rise over the mountains that surrounded us. We were split into two groups for our morning work, some preparing the foundation for a new house, the rest building a stove in a house that was close to being done. By evening, we were all amazed at the grace that the people of Guatemala displayed. They took great pride in what they have and were grateful to have help in improving their homes. We found Jesus within the people we had met and challenged ourselves to continue to do the same every day.

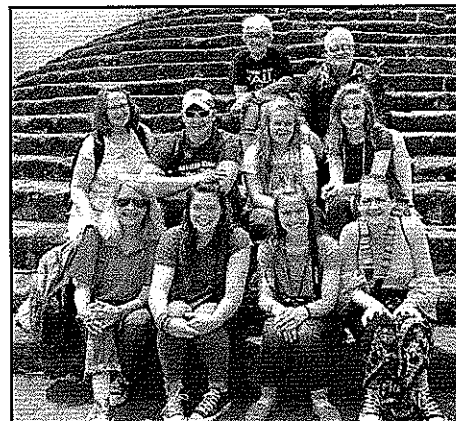
On day three, half of our group received the opportunity to work on the house-started the day before. When the walls became too high for some of us to reach, we had to find other ways to help. After dinner, some of our group walked to Central Park for karaoke and a pick-up game of basketball against some local teenagers. Our third day taught us to find joy in community, be it in our own group or not.

At the end of day four, we reflected on one particular person. Most of us had the opportunity to help Rene with building a retaining wall for the mission school. Our job was tedious, but whenever we passed him buckets of concrete or bags of dirt, he would say "Gracias" ~ no matter how many times we came back. He was an amazing example of patience and joy.

All week we talked about building relationships with the Guatemalans, but Thursday's pouring rain allowed us to bond and build deeper relationships with each other ~ simply by playing cards and through deep, reflective conversation ~ no devices!

The highlights of our final two days were the climb to the top of a volcanic ridge and a trip to Santiago Atitlan. Between these two days, we learned to appreciate the challenges and the simple things in our lives. We made it home safely. The trip passed by quickly, but it was an experience of a lifetime.

From the Desk of Deacon Bob

As disciples of Jesus, we are called to be a prophetic people. We received this call at our baptism when, anointed with holy chrism, we were anointed priest, prophet, and king. We come from a long line of prophets: Moses, Samuel, Elijah, Elisha, Amos, Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekial, Daniel, Hosea, Malachi, to name just a few.

The life of a prophet is not an easy one. There is no place for complacency in the life of a prophet. Prophets are called by God to leave their "zones of comfort and safety" and to go into places of uncertainty and distress and give witness to those who are in need of the Good News of Jesus. Prophets are called to be the conscience of peoples and nations. Prophets are called by God to challenge the unjust practices and policies of those who hold power. Prophets are called by God to be agents of change and to transform the systemic injustice of cultures and societies. As a result, prophets are often singled out by those in power as trouble makers and are often persecuted, imprisoned, and, at times, martyred. Numbered among Biblical prophets who suffered and died are our present-day prophets like Blessed Archbishop Oscar Romero, Dorothy Day, Martin Luther King Jr., and, even non-Christians like Mahatma Ghandi.

On this feast of the birth of John the Baptist, we are reminded that, like John the Baptist, we must prophesy to our present time and place, as prophets have done from of old. Our places to prophesy are not limited to only those mighty halls of government, but in our neighborhoods, our communities, and in our own homes. The graces that flow from the Mass into our lives provides us with the courage and the fortitude to bravely go forth and be heralds of Jesus Christ not only in word, but more importantly, in action.

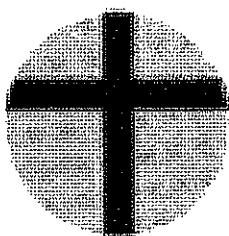

WESTERN CATHOLIC COMMUNITY St. John's & St. Scholastica

Some of you may have heard that meetings have occurred among some leaders within the WCC and its Pastor. The meetings regard the future of the St. John and St. Scholastica sites. These "planning meetings" are being convened at the request of the parish trustees, myself as Pastor, the Parish Pastoral Council, and with the full support of the Archdiocese and Archbishop Bernard Hebda. Plans are being made to engage the whole of the parish community this fall to accurately present the facts and do a discernment about what to do with the facts.

1. Two meetings with some WCC leadership were held May 31st and June 14th.
2. At these meetings a number of issues were presented to these leaders regarding:
 - the demographics of the parish,
 - the state of the buildings,
 - and the future these sites are likely facing.
3. Based on what we know right now, these facts call into question the viability of keeping both sites open.
4. No decision on the closure of one or both sites has been made. Again, to repeat, no decision on any closure has been made.
5. We are at the beginning of the process to decide what to do. Much more consultation with skilled people and the whole community will follow.
6. Dialogue in small groups and the community as a whole will extend into the fall of 2018. My intention, as Pastor, is that the dialogue will be thorough and as transparent as possible in making decisions.
6. As the dialogue moves forward more information will come to you about where the process stands.
7. Again, no conclusions have been arrived at this time. Please work to keep minds open and ready to respectfully deal with feelings and facts in this discernment. Unfounded negative comments and rumor mongering cause confusion, waste energy and derail good decisions being made.

Note: We look forward to welcoming Fr. Bob Hart to celebrate weekend Masses from July through September. On October 1st, Father Gene Theisen (ty' son) will begin serving as a New Prague Catholic Community full-time associate pastor.

Dear Members of the New Prague Area Catholic Community:

I am writing to you today regarding Father Dave Barrett. As you know, since November, Father Dave has been on a medical leave of absence that continues. Recognizing the ongoing pastoral needs of the New Prague Area Catholic Community (NPACC), a decision has been made that Father Dave will formally end his assignment here effective June 15, 2018. Father Dave will continue to focus his time towards his own personal health and ongoing healing.

I have spoken with Father Dave in writing this letter to you. He is deeply grateful for his seven years of ministry among us and the many kindnesses and relationships that have happened. Our staff and parishioners join me in appreciating Father Dave's priestly service. We thank him for what he has given us.

With this decision, please note that beginning July 6, 2018, Father Bob Hart will be assisting the NPACC with liturgical ministry from Friday through Sunday. Father Bob will retire from active ministry as a pastor on July 1, 2018. He will be with us until the end of September. I both welcome and thank Father Bob for his willingness to serve us.

On October 1, 2018, Father Eugene Theisen will join the NPACC. Archbishop Hebda has appointed Father Eugene to serve as Parochial Vicar (Associate Pastor) for our community. Father Eugene is currently on sabbatical after many years of service as a military chaplain. He has also served in a parish setting in the Archdiocese. I am very pleased that he will be joining us.
