El Santo Evangelio según San Lucas (Lc 5: 1-11)

En aquel tiempo, Jesús estaba a orillas del lago de Genesaret y la gente se agolpaba en torno suyo para oír la palabra de Dios. Jesús vio dos barcas que estaban junto a la orilla. Los pescadores habían desembarcado y estaban lavando las redes. Subió Jesús a una de las barcas, la de Simón, le pidió que la alejara un poco de tierra, y sentado en la barca, enseñaba a la multitud.

Cuando acabó de hablar, dijo a Simón: “Lleva la barca mar adentro y echen sus redes para pescar”. Simón replicó: “Maestro, hemos trabajado toda la noche y no hemos pescado nada; pero, confiado en tu palabra, echaré las redes”. Así lo hizo y cogieron tal cantidad de pescados, que las redes se rompían. Entonces hicieron señas a sus compañeros, que estaban en la otra barca, para que vinieran a ayudarlos. Vinieron ellos y llenaron tanto las dos barcas, que casi se hundían.

Al ver esto, Simón Pedro se arrojó a los pies de Jesús y le dijo: “¡Apártate de mí, Señor, porque soy un pecador!” Porque tanto él como sus compañeros estaban llenos de asombro al ver la pesca que habían conseguido. Lo mismo les pasaba a Santiago y a Juan, hijos de Zebedeo, que eran compañeros de Simón.

Entonces Jesús le dijo a Simón: “No temas; desde ahora serás pescador de hombres”. Luego llevaron las barcas a tierra y, dejándolo todo, lo siguieron. **Palabra de Dios.**

Reflexión

Hoy el Evangelio nos ofrece una gran enseñanza a través del corto diálogo entre Jesús y Simón Pedro, que muy bien podríamos hacerlo nuestro, sobre todo cuando buscamos éxito en nuestros propósitos y metas en general, como cuando buscamos la buena pesca a través del anuncio del Evangelio con nuestros hijos, familiares y amigos. Entonces es cuando vemos la dura realidad de que nuestros esfuerzos y estrategias para conseguirlos no son suficientes y descubrimos lo fundamental, que consiste ante todo, confiar en Jesús quien nos prometió nunca dejarnos solos. También recordamos aquellas palabras de María en las bodas de Caná: “**Hagan lo que Él les diga**”, porque solo en el cumplimiento confiado de la voluntad del Señor, nuestro trabajo resultará provechoso.

Otra enseñanza es la humilde confesión de Pedro de su condición pecadora, diciéndole a Jesús: “Apártate de mí, Señor, porque soy un pecador”. Pedro se siente pecador por desconfiar de la orden de Jesús de que reme mar adentro, dándole razones humanas a quien es el autor divino de todo cuanto existe. Así aprendemos que solo siendo conscientes de nuestra naturaleza pecadora seremos capaces de reconocer que somos criaturas limitadas, necesitadas de Dios, reconocimiento que nos pone ante la evidencia de Dios que nos supera infinitamente en todo, porque para Él nada hay imposible y **el único verdadero pescador es Él.**

Podemos concluir que saber aceptar nuestras limitaciones y confiar en la voluntad y sabiduría de Dios, es aceptar que los frutos posibles de nuestro trabajo apostólico son solo de Dios, a quien hemos servido como instrumentos. Esa fue la sabiduría de San Francisco de Asís cuando le pide a Dios ser instrumento de su paz, de su amor, de su perdón, de su luz, etc. De ser así nosotros, también Jesús nos responderá como a Pedro: “No temas. Desde ahora serás pescador de hombres”, ya que solo el encuentro auténtico con Dios nos llevará a reconocer nuestra pobreza e insuficiencia, nuestras limitaciones y nuestro pecado. Y aún a pesar de nuestra fragilidad Jesús, rico en misericordia y en perdón, transformará nuestras vidas y nos llamará a seguirlo, haciéndonos sus discípulos y heraldos de la salvación nuestra y de nuestros hermanos. **¡Paz y Bien!**

The Holy Gospel According to St Luke (LK 5: 1-11)

While the crowd was pressing in on Jesus and listening to the word of God, he was standing by the Lake of Gennesaret. He saw two boats there alongside the lake; the fishermen had disembarked and were washing their nets. Getting into one of the boats, the one belonging to Simon, he asked him to put out a short distance from the shore. Then he sat down and taught the crowds from the boat.

After he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Put out into deep water and lower your nets for a catch." Simon said in reply, "Master, we have worked hard all night and have caught nothing, but at your command I will lower the nets." When they had done this, they caught a great number of fish and their nets were tearing. They signaled to their partners in the other boat to come to help them. They came and filled both boats so that the boats were in danger of sinking. When Simon Peter saw this, he fell at the knees of Jesus and said, "Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man." For astonishment at the catch of fish they had made seized him and all those with him, and likewise James and John, the sons of Zebedee, who were partners of Simon. Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching men." When they brought their boats to the shore, they left everything and followed him. *The Gospel of the Lord*

Reflection

Today the Gospel offers us a great teaching through the short dialogue between Jesus and Simon Peter, which we could very well see it as our own dialogue with Jesus, especially when we seek success in our purpose and goals in general, as when we seek "abundant fish" through the announcement of the Gospel with our children, family and friends. That is when we see the harsh reality that our efforts and strategies to achieve them are not enough and we realize the fundamental, which consists above all, to trust in Jesus who promised never to leave us alone. We also remember those words of Mary at the wedding at Cana: "**Do whatever He tells you**", because only in the confident fulfillment of the Lord's will, our work will be profitable.

Another teaching is of Peter's humble confession of his sinful condition, telling Jesus: "Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man." Peter feels that he is a sinner because he mistrusts Jesus' command to go out into the sea, giving human excuses to the one who is the divine author of all that exists. Thus, we learn that only by being aware of our sinful nature will we be able to recognize that we are limited creatures, in need of God, a realization that puts us before the evidence of God who infinitely surpasses us in everything, because for Him nothing is impossible and that **the only true fisherman is Him**. We can conclude that, knowing to accept our limitations and trusting in the will and wisdom of God, is to accept that the possible fruits of our apostolic work are only attributed to God, whom we have served as instruments. That was the wisdom of Saint Francis of Assisi when he asked God for him to be an instrument of his peace, his love, his forgiveness, his light, etc. If we are like that, Jesus will also respond to us like Peter: "Do not be afraid. From now on you will be a fisher of men ", because only the authentic encounter with God will lead us to recognize our poverty and insufficiency, our limitations and our sin, and even in spite of our fragility, Jesus, rich in mercy and forgiveness, will transform our lives and he will call us to follow him, making us his disciples and heralds of our salvation and of our brothers.

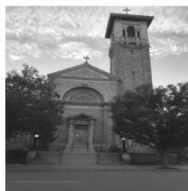

This position assists the Income Management Coordinator with the food programs and is based at Casa San Francisco, an emergency shelter for adults, in Milton, Delaware.

Essential Functions include: Provide assistance with the semi-monthly distribution of food to club members. Support existing food clubs and assist in recruitment of new food club members. Keep accurate records of orders and receipts. Collect and deliver the payments to the Income Management Coordinator for recording and deposit in the bank. 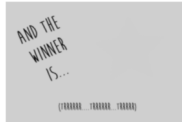
