**All You Can Eat Brunch: Lincoln**

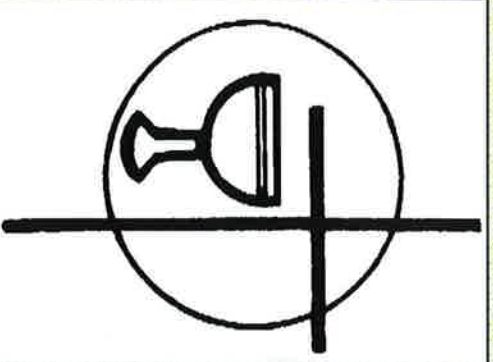


