**Breaking Open the Word**

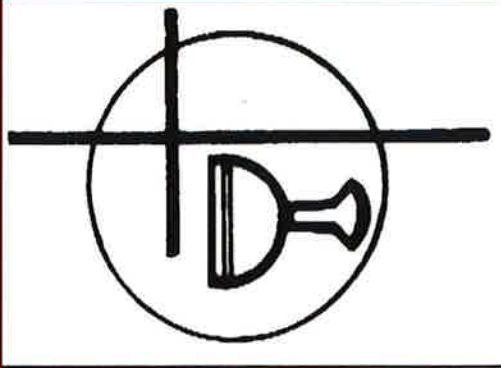
