**Kick-off dates:**

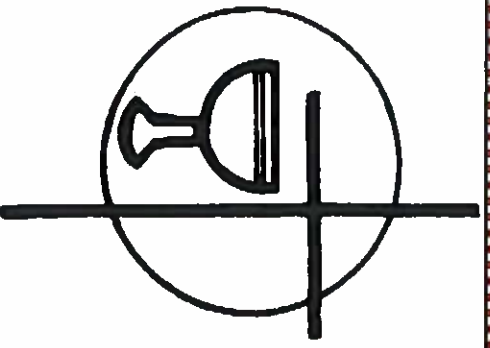
