Ulster County Respect Life Dinner will be Friday October 24th this year. At our dinner we feature a journal with advertisements and a patron section.

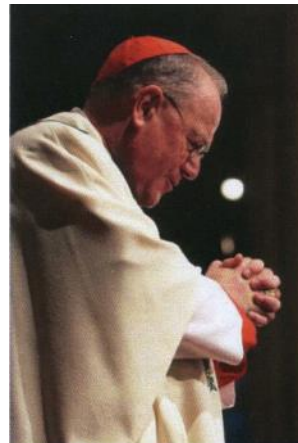
