RULES OF FASTING and ABSTINENCE

**Fasting means eating only one full meal.** Two smaller meals may be taken which do not equal the full meal. **Good Friday is a fast day.** Everyone between the ages of 18 and 59 is bound to the fasting obligation. **Abstinence means not eating meat. Meat consumption is forbidden on all the Fridays of Lent.** This obligation begins at age 14 and has no upper limit.
