
Fifth Sunday of Easter April 24, 2016



Reflection on the Scriptures

"I give you a new commandment." John 13:34

The Lord makes all things new (Revelations 21:5). WE will see "new heavens and a new earth" (Revelations 21:1). We will see "a new Jerusalem" (Revelations 21:2). The Lord makes all things new through us, especially as we obey the new commandment of love (John 13:34). "This means that if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old order has passed away; now all is new!" (2 Corinthians 5:17). The Holy Spirit is renewing "the face of the earth" (Psalms 104:30). "All that matters is that one is created anew" (Galatians 6:15).

Although the Lord Is making all things new, we often prefer the old to the new (see Luke 5:39). In our selfishness, we value the comfort of the old life more highly than the sacrifices, sufferings, and love in the new life. We must change our minds, repent, and deny ourselves (see Luke 9:23), or we will reject the new, insist on continuing the old life of selfishness and sin, and go to the same old hell.

Jesus says: "See, I make all thing new!" (Revelations 21:5) Do you see? Are you new? Choose new!
