This is a wonderful way of almsgiving because not only are you giving up something, you are also learning about and helping those who are the poorest of the poor in our world.

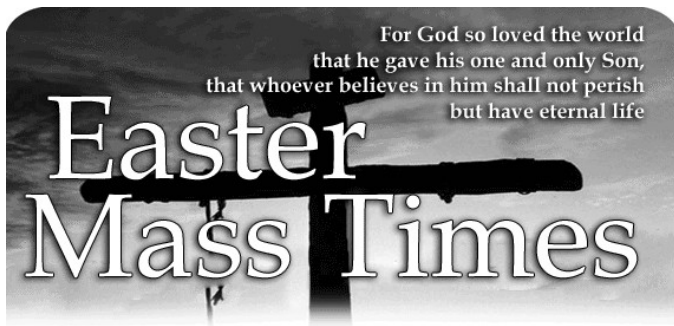

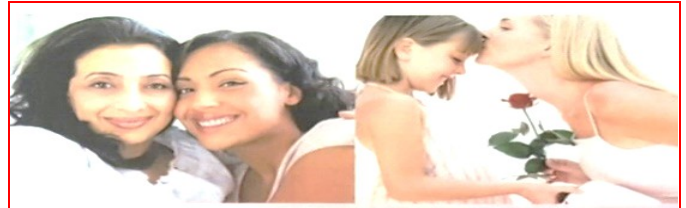
Godparents who live in another parish require a letter from their pastor recommending them as godparents.

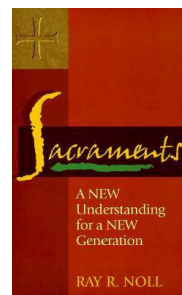
